## CHAN WARD

Over 1500 Darwin residents participated in the 2019 Darwin Place Census completing either a Town Care Factor survey or Street PX (Place Experience) Assessment. When the community's values are considered against place performance six individual attributes have been identified for investment consideration across the local government area. This fact sheet provides an overview of the results for Chan Ward.

City of Darwin has completed a survey of Darwin residents and visitors - the 2019 Darwin Place Score Census - to assess the most highly valued attributes and assets in our city and suburbs.

Chan Ward comprises the suburbs of Coconut Grove, Jingili, Ludmilla, Millner, Moil, Nightcliff and Rapid Creek.

- 258 people told us what they care about most in the Chan Ward.
- Chan Ward was the only ward that did not rate cleanliness as one of the top thing things they care about.
- The top 3 place attributes valued by the Chan Ward relate to vegetation and natural environment.
- All Wards rated elements of the natural environment as one of the top 3 priorities
- The Chan Wards is the only ward to identify walking, Cycling and public transport as something which is valued.
- Chan Ward residents in Rapid Creek and Nightcliff care a lot about physical connectivity and movement with walking, cycling or public transport options and walking paths that connect to their places key values for that community.
- Rapid Creek is the only town centre that rated public art, community art, water or light features in the top 3 things that they care about.
- 67% of men rate the Sense of Safety as the number 2 priority in Parap
- 58% of Nightcliff residents care about seeking evidence of public events happening.
- Consideration of Local History, heritage buildings or features should be given in Chan Ward
- People over 45-64 years of age are more likely (57%) to be concerned with the overall look and visual character of the area then those under 44 years old.
